MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

BEAUTY & WELLNESS SECTOR SKILL COUNCIL (B&WSSC)

AND

KUMARI VIDYAVATI ANAND D.A.V. COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, KARNAL

Executed on this 7th day of May 2025 at New Delhi.

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

In recognition of the proven value of skills-based teaching in the mainstream education system; Beauty & Wellness Sector Skill Council (hereinafter referred to as B&WSSC), a Society, registered under the Societies Registration Act, established jointly by the Industry and National Skill Development Corporation of India, having its office at 5-B, Upper GF, 23 Himalaya House K. G. Marg, Connaught Place, New Delhi, 110001. and represented by Ms. Monica Bahl, CEO, which expression shall unless, repugnant in the context and meaning thereof shall mean and include its successors in business, legal representatives permitted assigns, as First Party and Kumari Vidyavati Anand D.A.V. College for Women having its registered office at Railway Karnal, Haryana, 132001 and represented by the Principal, which expression shall unless, repugnant in the context and meaning thereof shall mean and include its successors in business, legal representatives permitted assigns, as Second Party.

Either party may change its designated officer by written notification to the designated liaison officer of the other party. The officers will inform each other of the delegation of duties within the respective institutions' staff for the implementation of programs, and routine communication.

RENEWAL, REVIEW, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT OF THE MOU

- This MoU should be signed by official representatives of both the parties.
- It will be effective from the date of the last signature for an initial period of two years. Thereafter, it shall be automatically extended for an additional period of two years at each expiration date unless either party provides written notice to terminate the MoU a minimum of six months prior to the expiration date.
- Both parties will regularly review the program(s) on a six-monthly basis. The review is essential in order to make appropriate and mutually agreed modifications as may be required and to identify new opportunities for cooperation.
- Either party reserves the right to withdraw from this MoU by giving six-month written notice to termination. Programs planned or in progress when termination is initiated, will be satisfactorily completed.
- Items not covered by the MoU may be raised and negotiated separately by both parties without abrogating this MoU. Amendments or changes shall be made in writing and signed by the duly authorized representatives of the institutions.
- If any provision of this MoU is found to conflict with any laws, statutes or regulations in force at that point in time, such provision will be null and void, but all other provisions without such conflicts shall remain in effect.
- In case of any misunderstandings, all issues to be discussed and resolved amicably.
- This MoU has been signed in quadruplicate and each institution will receive two copies.
- Jurisdiction of this MoU shall be the courts of Delhi.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- Intellectual property rights (IPR) of existing work products used for activities under scope of this MoU shall remain under ownership of their respective owners. However, in the interest of activities to be carried out under the scope of this MoU, the party owning a work product may assign the other party rights for use / share a work product through a separately documented assignment or undertaking for the purpose.
- IPR for any new work product developed as a part of activities under this association, shall remain vested with B&WSSC.
- For any change in ownership of IPR, both the parties shall carry out necessary modalities prior to initiating such activity leading to creation of a work product.

The primary purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding ["MoU"] is to extend expertise to each other to contribute to the students & society at large with specific focus on the skill development, offer B.Voc Program(s), training for the beauty & wellness sector.

Following are the areas that are considered as the scope for the association –

1. B&WSSC will support Kumari Vidyavati Anand D.A.V. College for Women, Karnal in its training initiatives for conducting the B.Voc program in beauty & wellness sector like providing model curriculum and relevant study material.
2. B&WSSC will provide necessary technical guidance to Kumari Vidyavati Anand D.A.V. College for Women, Karnal for setting up Centre of Excellence & Wellness Training facilities to support the training programs.
3. The training of the trainers (ToT) will be conducted by B&WSSC for Kumari Vidyavati Anand D.A.V. College for Women, Karnal (only SSC certified trainer can train the students). Payment terms for ToT shall be agreed between the two parties prior to each such trainings.
4. B&WSSC may undertake Master Trainer programs at Kumari Vidyavati Anand D.A.V. College for Women, Karnal for the relevant programs. Payment terms shall be agreed between the two parties prior to initiating each such program.
5. B&WSSC will provide print-ready learning materials/e-content for B.Voc program in Beauty & Wellness.
6. Kumari Vidyavati Anand D.A.V. College for Women, Karnal will provide adequate space for setting up of Lab. B&WSSC will provide necessary technical assistance for setting up the same.
7. Kumari Vidyavati Anand D.A.V. College for Women, Karnal shall mobilize the candidates at all its centres where training for B.Voc program in Beauty & Wellness will be conducted.
8. Kumari Vidyavati Anand D.A.V. College for Women, Karnal will follow the guidelines of B&WSSC in operation of its centres where training for B.Voc program in Beauty & Wellness will be conducted.
9. The assessment and certification of the students trained under B.Voc program of Beauty & Wellness will be conducted by B&WSSC only. Payment terms shall be agreed between the two parties prior to conducting the assessment. Modalities for the areas of cooperation shall be worked out and described individually with mutual consent of the partners keeping regulations, rules, policies and guidelines of each partner in view.

COMMUNICATION

Each party will designate liaison officer to coordinate with each other for this partnership.

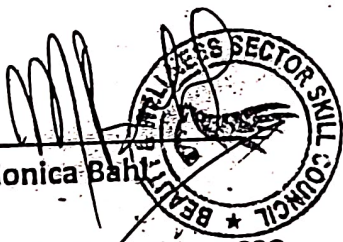
OTHER COVENANTS
