Elderly Care-taker (Non-clinical) & Child Care-taker (Non-clinical)

Under the visionary and exemplary leadership of the Principal, Mrs. Meenu Sharma, the college continues to pioneer skill-based and socially relevant education. Recognised by NSDC and HMCSSC, two certificate courses – Elderly Care-taker (Non-clinical) and Child Care-taker (Non-clinical) were introduced in the academic session 2024-25 under the aegis of IQAC of the college. These courses are designed to equip students with practical competencies and a compassionate outlook essential for caregiving professions. Under the dedicated guidance of the course coordinators, Dr Deepti Sharma and Mrs Harbinder Kaur, along with the teacher-in-charge Ms Preeti, a group of twelve students actively participated in all academic and practical components, gaining in-depth exposure to this vital field.

A series of enriching, hands-on activities aimed at providing holistic training were organised for the students who actively participated in meal preparation tailored to different age groups and were trained in essential life-saving and survival skills, including first aid, operation of fire extinguishers, blood pressure monitoring, wheelchair handling, and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). These activities not only strengthened their technical knowledge but also instilled confidence, empathy, and a strong sense of responsibility.

To bridge the gap between theory and practical, students from both courses were assigned Internships/On-the-Job Training (OJT) with reputed organisations. The Child Care-takers received practical training at *Model Day Care Centre, Bal Bhavan, Karnal*, while the Elderly Care-takers underwent training at *Nirmal Dham, Model Town, Karnal*. This hands-on experience enabled students to apply classroom learning in real-life settings, refine their caregiving skills, and develop professional competence along with empathy and sensitivity.

At the culmination of the session, following the successful completion of examinations, each student was awarded two certificates - one recognising the completion of the course from the Skill Sector Council and the other acknowledging their Internship/OJT from the respective organisations.

The Department of Care-giver, thus continues to play a significant role in fostering skill development, social responsibility, and employability, preparing students to contribute meaningfully to society with compassion, dedication, and competence.
