ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19

KVA DAV College for Women, Karnal, holds the distinction of being an institution that strives to keep alive the anglo-vedic ideal propounded by Swami Dayanand Saraswati, the founder of Arya Samaj. We focus on building a future generation which assimilates the best of 'faith' and 'logic'. Our students take from us goal-oriented and value-added knowledge that enables them to realize their potential and abilities to the optimum. Established in 1958 (by a group of Arya Samajis led by Lal Makhan Lal Ji, Dr Ganesh Das ji and Principal Mela Ram Ji Barq) with only hundred students, 4 lecturers and 4 members of non-teaching staff, the college presently has a strength of 2504 students and 481 students in add-on-courses with 270 girls in the hostel, 108 teaching-staff and 53 members of non-teaching staff.

After twenty-eight years of its inception, the management of the college was handed over to DAV College Managing Committee, New Delhi, which is the biggest, non-government educational society in India that runs more than 900 institutions across all parts of India and abroad. The name of Kumari Vidyavati Anandji was prefixed in 1997 in honour of the selfless and magnanimous services rendered in the field of education by this noble soul.

Over the years, the college has earned the fame and renown as a premier institution of the area. It was declared a "Model College" and "Pace-setting Women's College" by National Institute of Education Planning and Administration in 1992. Accredited Grade 'A' by NAAC, in 2016, the college is a crown of glory in the echelons of higher education for girls.

The college envisions to provide a distinct environment of excellence in education with humane values and social commitment to enable the students so as to reach their full potential as human beings as well as members of the society.
