2024 -2025

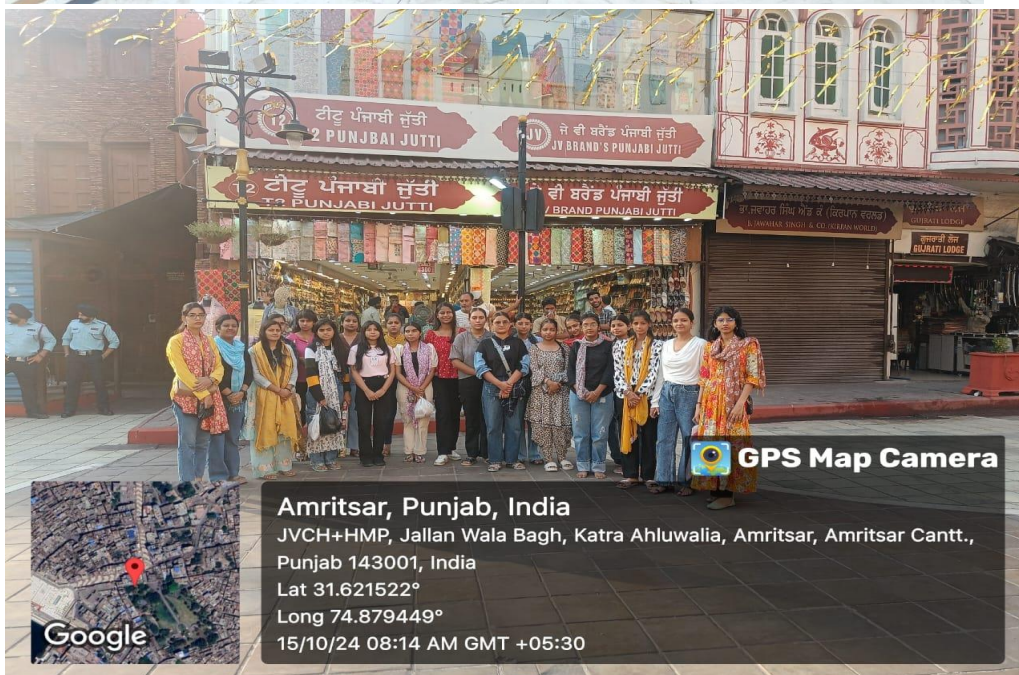

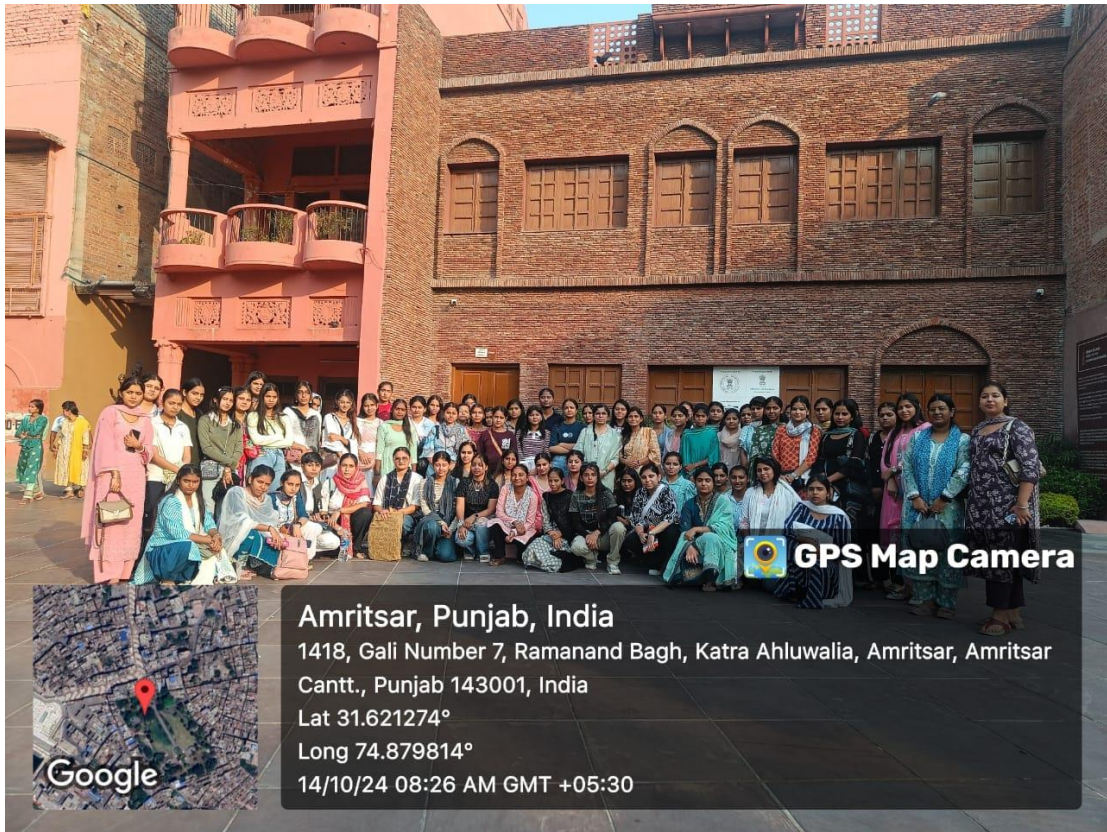
Some of the activity details are mentioned below:

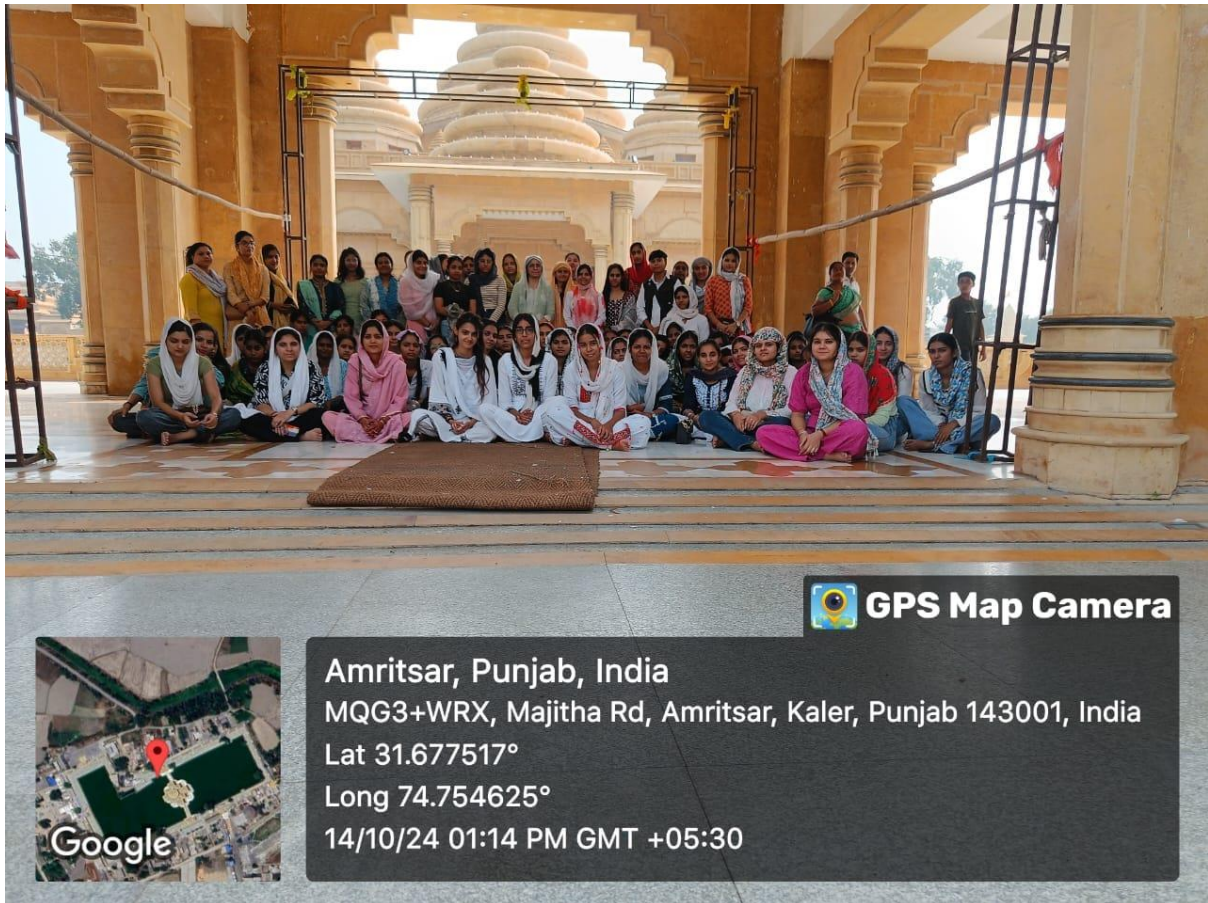
