

Activities of Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship Cell

Session 2025-26

The Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship Cell, under the aegis of IQAC, promotes innovation, creativity and entrepreneurship among students through mentorship, guidance and practical exposure. Under the able guidance of the Principal, Ms Meenu Sharma, the Cell encourages students to develop entrepreneurial skills and become confident, self-reliant and financially independent. Several students have initiated ventures in areas such as beauty and wellness, fashion and design, coaching and other small enterprises, reflecting the College's commitment to "WE"- Women Empowerment.

The following activities were organised during the academic session 2025-26 to promote innovation, entrepreneurship, skill development, self-employment and self-reliance among students:

1. World Entrepreneurship Day was celebrated through the live streaming of the event organised by Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar on August 21, 2025, graced by the presence of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Haryana. The live streaming was arranged as per the directions of the DHEO, Karnal. The event highlighted the importance of entrepreneurship, innovation, self-employment and self-reliance among youth. 56 students attended the live streaming of the event.
2. The Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship Cell in collaboration with Youth Red Cross of the college organised a Visit to Prakriti Mahotsav 2025, Karnal held at NDRI, Karnal on August 22, 2025. The theme of the day was Self-reliant India through Agroforestry or Tree farming. The workshop was followed by an exhibition and cultural activities. 13 students and one teacher participated.
3. World Entrepreneurship Fortnight (Vishwa Udhyaamita Pakhwada) and Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyan was celebrated by Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship Cell, Anti-Drug Awareness Cell, Youth Red Cross, and the Department of Political Science of the college from August 26-28, 2025. The event comprised five extension lectures and an oath ceremony aimed at motivating students towards entrepreneurship and self-reliance and certificates to the winners of Slogan and Poster competitions. The resource persons for the extension lectures included Mr. Vikas Atri, Retd Principal, Govt College, Assandh; Mrs. Saroj Chawla, Retd Principal, Govt Girls College, Karnal; Mrs. Meenu Chawla, Former President, Bharat Vikas Parishad, Krishan Shaka, Karnal. Two distinguished entrepreneurs, who are proud alumnae of the college-Mrs. Nandini Bajaj, Founder of Chocokala India and Gift Gharana, Karnal, and Ms. Vidhi, Founder of Vidushi Creations and Boutique, Kunjpura Road, Karnal were specially honoured during the programme. Their inspiring journeys encouraged students to explore entrepreneurial opportunities and develop innovative ideas. The programme concluded with an oath ceremony, where students pledged to adopt entrepreneurial values, work towards self-employment, and contribute positively to society. The lecture series proved to be highly informative and motivational, fostering entrepreneurial awareness and confidence among the students. The students received training in Graphic Designing via Canva, Candle-making and other creative and digital skills aiming at developing practical, creative and income-generating skills among students. They were encouraged to explore opportunities for self-employment and small-scale entrepreneurship.
6. A workshop on “Incubation, Start-ups and Entrepreneurship” was organised on October 15, 2025. The Resource Person was Dr Sunant Grover, Entrepreneur and Founder, The Finishing School, Karnal. He addressed students on the importance of entrepreneurship, self-employment opportunities, start-up opportunities, creative thinking and innovation. Vision of a self-reliant India, government schemes and support systems for new ventures and emerging start-ups. were also shared with the students. The session was informative, interactive and motivating. 115 students participated in the workshop.
7. Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights was organized by November 21, 2025 to create awareness about the protection of intellectual and creative work. Dr. Anuradha Nagia attended the workshop. The workshop focused on the importance of protecting innovations, original ideas, creative works, designs and other intellectual creations and enhanced the understanding of the role of Intellectual Property Rights in promoting innovation and entrepreneurship.

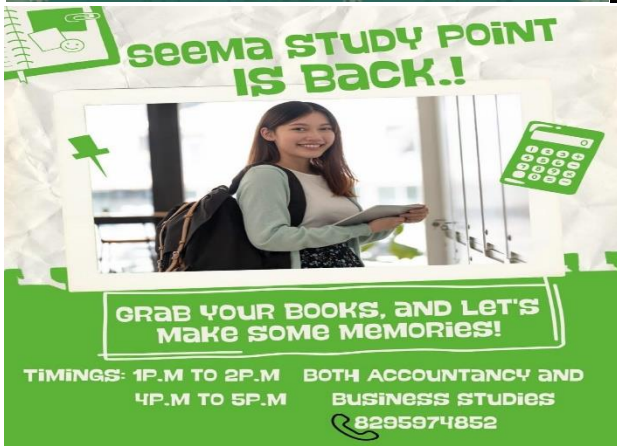
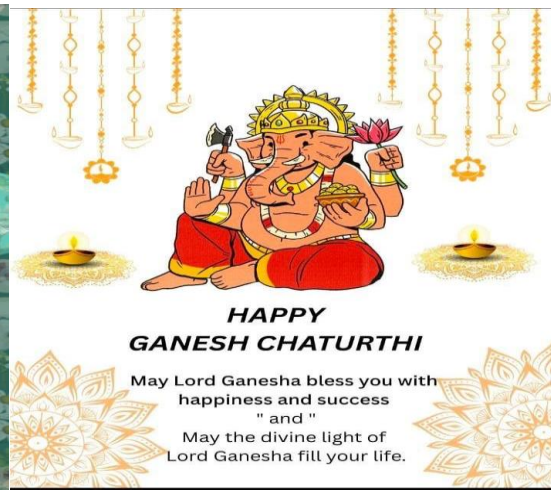
